## 8. Payment

Travel Expenses will be transferred to each Team's bank account in Holmenkollen in the Raw Air Secretariat in the Scandic Holmenkollen Park. Please note that it will not be possible to receive cash.

Prize Money will be paid by bank transfer to the Athletes after the FIS World Cup RAW AIR Tournament.

In addition to the prize money regulated by the FIS WC rules there will be paid extra prize money to the FIS World Cup RAW AIR Tournament overall top 3 athletes.

## 9. Income tax information for prize money

- The current Norwegian tax rate for non resident athletes is 15%.  
Due to a special tax convention between Norway and USA, income tax will not be deducted by the OC for income less than USD10000 – “the income shall be taxable only in the State of which the sportsman is a resident”.
- Tax will be deducted by the OC according to the Norwegian *Foreign Artist Taxation Act*, and taxes will be paid by the OC according to the regular tax legislation in Norway.

## 10. Waxing facilities – location

Lillehammer: close to the outrun in the ski jumping hill

Holmenkollen: close to the ski jumping hill – behind the lift lobby

There will be no ski-waxing rooms available at the hotels.

## 11. Regulations of radio equipment

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Norway is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radiotransmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications. For further information and application form (‘Application for temporary use of radios in Norway’) see: [www.npt.no](http://www.npt.no). The application must be forwarded before 1 February.

## Important information regarding Covid-19-protocol and Travel to Norway

---

### Travel to Norway

Currently (04.01.22), the following rules applies for all persons arriving in Norway:

1. Registration through the Norwegian entry registration system, [entry registration](#).
2. Test at the border/airport after arrival in Norway

**Persons holding a verifiable Covid 19 Certificate** (fully vaccinated or recently infected) approved by the Norwegian authorities, do not have any other obligations due to testing or quarantine according to Norwegian rules. For these persons the requirements in the FIS World Cup testing protocol applies.

### Persons without a verifiable Covid 19 Certificate have the following obligations:

- You are required to take a test (PCR or antigen) also **before** arrival in Norway (test must be taken less than 24 hrs before arrival, certificate has to be presented at the border)
- For the first days of your stay in Norway, athletes and staff taking part in international sport events approved by the Norwegian government are subject to quarantine under the following obligations:
- Accommodation in single rooms
- Test (antigen) every day during quarantine
- You are allowed to take part in competitions, training and other parts of the competition programme during quarantine
- After day 3, you have the possibility to end quarantine after a negative PCR-test

### All persons accredited to Raw Air 2022 are obliged to follow the FIS World Cup Risk Management Covid 19 Testing Protocol and the tournaments own Covid 19 Protocol.

According to the FIS protocol, all athletes and staff must have and present a negative PCR-test carried out at least 48 hours prior to accreditation and complete a Health Questionnaire.

All team members and officials have to update all necessary information in the FIS covid-19-passport according to FIS rules.

### Accommodation

All teams and staff have to follow the OC accommodation system. No possibilities to stay outside of OC accommodation

### Costs

Additional costs for single rooms because of the Norwegian quarantine rules will be covered by the OC. Costs for SARS-CoV-2-tests in Norway has to be covered by the respective ski federation. Prizes; TBA.

### Other

Face masks must be used by all persons both outside and inside, except during training and competitions.

### Transport and luggage

Raw Air Tournament will handle the transport for all Teams according to Covid-19 restrictions.

Each team will be assigned to a specific bus and have to sit on the same bus the whole tournament.

To avoid crowded departure and arrival from/to the hotels a detailed time schedule for transport will follow.

Everyone has to handle their own personal luggage. The bus driver will help with loading and unloading the luggage according to Covid-19 restrictions.
